



Coaches' Commitment Policy

Objective:

To define what a coach must agree to when applying for a head coaching position with the NCHA.

Accountabilities:

The NCHA Board will require all head coaches to agree to participate with the development and organization of each of their teams and divisions. NCHA is looking to improve the communication, team work and development from the Board to the coaching staff.

- Dry land training will be left to the discretion of the coach and team.
- Commit (if applicable) to Off-ice testing protocol – NOHA / Hockey Canada
- Commit to NCHA Player development, as per Hockey Canada LTPD model – specialty skills training \$50 / player
- Commit to 15 players and 2 goalies.
- Commit to following “ Coach Reimbursement Policy”
- Commit to NCHA standardized tryout –“cut” and “selected” procedures.
- Commit to the affiliation program for practices and games.
- Commit to working with all coaches in your division.
- Commit to attending, or send at least one representative, to all coaches meeting throughout the year.
- Commit to abide by all Hockey Canada, OHF, NOHA rules, policies and regulations, including maintaining required certifications and courses for age and division coached.
