



Outside of Canada Travel

Objective:

To ensure NCHA teams are adequately covered when travelling to tournaments outside Canada.

Applicability:

This applies to all NCHA coaches/teams. Tournaments must be sanctioned, which includes tournaments sanctioned by Hockey USA, or other countries travelling to.

Process:

1. Please remember, when teams plan to travel to a tournament outside of Canada, they need to ensure they have passports and permission letters to cross the border, if the parents are separated/divorced or if only one parent is travelling with the child.

2. You will require a tournament permit and an approved HCR roster.
3. We also highly recommend that you obtain out of country insurance (Blue Cross) for the players and staff. Hockey Canada insurance only covers bills in Canadian dollars at Canadian rates. Also, it is secondary insurance to parent's coverage and OHIP coverage
