



NCHA Player Development Model

- The NCHA collects money through association player fees used for player and coach development.
- Each team will receive a budget of **\$50 per rostered player** to use as Player Development Funds towards NCHA approved Instructors and Mentors.
- Teams will have a dedicated instructor/mentor for each age group.
NOTE: Alternative player development instruction will not be refunded with the allocated funds set aside by NCHA. (*Goalie Training is not applicable, and has separate allocated funds.*)
- Coaches are required to get in contact with the Instructor/Mentor and have a Player Development Plan organized and scheduled. Form is available through the NCHA website.
- Use the Player Development tracking sheet provided by NCHA. Forward the tracked information to *Corey Crane* (coreycrane1316@gmail.com) and *Mary Ellen* (mary_ellen.parks@nickelcityhockey.ca)
- Teams will require to dedicate 1 practice per month to Player Development starting in September and finishing the end of January.

NOTE: Reimbursement process as follows:

- Instructors/Mentors will supply a Player Development Tracking sheet to Mary Ellen mary_ellen.parks@nickelcityhockey.ca including - Date, Time and the Name of the Instructor/Mentor and Team that received the Development for each individual player development session.
- The Coach or Manager for the corresponding team must sign for confirmation that the session was completed.
- Mary Ellen will use the Player Development fees allotted for each player to pay the Instructors/Mentors at months end, when sessions have been completed.



NCHA Approved Instructors/Mentors

- Teams will have 1 Player Development session each month with a total of 5 sessions for the season, beginning in September and completing at the end of January. Coaches will collaborate with the Instructors/Mentors to gain experience and knowledge towards practices and game situations. This will be a team effort and the coaches will not feel alone. The coaches are encouraged to use them as references and sounding boards in all aspects of the game.

- Goalie Instructors will supply an invoice to the Teams, who will pay the Instructors.
- Teams will supply the Player Development Tracking sheet to Mary Ellen mary_ellen.parks@nickelcityhockey.ca including - Date, Time, Payment and the Name of the Instructor/Mentor.
- Mary Ellen will use the Goalie Development fees allotted to reimburse the Team's Ice Bills.
